- Nick will talk a little about our Fathers program, and what his role is here. (10 min.)
- We will give a tour. (10 Min.)
- End with the choices that the girl made and ask them what they think of her choice. ( 5 Min.)
- Have Pamphlets available.

**Challenge to the Boys:** After going through the one hour presentation the boys will be charged with coming up for a way to help EPS through drives or money raising events such as walk-a-thons that can be done at the Mount. These are just a couple of ideas but the boys can be creative and come up with their own ideas that would help out EPS.

**Note:** A lot of colleges are now looking for service hours that have to do with designing/building their own way to help the community – this fits in that category!

**Number of Service Hours:** The boys might be able to get all their service hours doing this one event. One hour will be the presentation but the real hours build up when they plan, implement and conclude their activity that assists EPS.
