

SUGGESTED LIST FOR BOARDING STUDENTS

BEDDING/PERSONAL ITEMS

Pillow/pillow case
Sheets - one set- twin size
Blankets - 1-2 (bedspreads are furnished for freshmen)
Laundry bag/basket - large
Wash cloths
Bath size towels
Toiletry items and basket (soap, shampoo, deodorant, toothbrush, toothpaste, etc)

SUGGESTION: The lockers for freshman measure depth by width: 17"x 19", so certain plastic bins make handy shelves. Freshmen have two lockers this size. Clothes may also be hung on hangers in the lockers.

BAND (you'll need your musical instrument if in band. Practice is at 7:00 a.m. 2x/week)
