- **12. INCLEMENT WEATHER**: With winter approaching, we want to remind everyone of our inclement weather policy. The policy is in our handbook but here is a recap.

Mount Michael is **NOT** part of any group closing, including Elkhorn Public Schools or Omaha Catholic Schools. Weather decisions will <u>always</u> be made independently by the school administration. Inclement weather may lead to school being canceled or starting late (at either 8:40 or 10:00 am). Should Mount Michael be closed due to the weather, it will always be communicated directly by the school via email, an automated voice/text system, social media, or reported to local news stations. Due to our unusual status as a boarding school, we will try to make weather decisions the evening before whenever possible. This particularly applies to Sundays or other days when many students need to make the decision to return to campus or not. However, this early decision is not always possible. When a decision to close school is made in the morning, our goal is to communicate this by 6:30 am.

Mount Michael does not always close when other schools do. Mount Michael never closes just because of extremely low temperatures or wind chill advisories. Closures will normally be limited to snow, ice, and so on. At times, the decision to close will be made when students are already on campus, especially boarding students. The residential dean staff will provide supervision and meals for these students. If a student on campus wants to return home after school has been canceled, he will be allowed to go home ONLY when the roads are deemed safe enough to drive on, and then only when his parent has communicated with the dean that they give him permission to leave.
